

"Ahead of the Curve" May 4th

EITHER

- 1 x 12" (30cm) foam wreath ring with polystyrene base (not NAYLOR base) a used wreath ring can be re-cycled
- 8 test tubes
- Pot tape and knife
- Sufficient leaves to cover the ring eg camellia/ivy/laurel/senecio
- Pins to secure leaves
- 1 bunch beargrass
- 8/10 germini or other flowers

OR

- 1 x 12" (30cm foam wreath ring (with base of your choice)
- Glass bowl or dish to fit snugly into centre of ring
- 10 midelino sticks or flexigrass or aluminium wire
- Selection of short foliage to cover ring
- 5/7 focal flowers eg germini/chrysanthemums
- 5/7 smaller flowers eg roses/carnations
- Selection of filler flowers eg lisianthus/spray carnations/veronica/berries
- 5 calla lillies of a toning shade

"Flirty Foliage" June 1st

- A container of your choice
- Green foam to fit container
- Sharp knife and pot tape
- Some or all of the following:
 - 5 or 6 ivy Leaves
 - 4 or 5 fatsia Leaves
 - 3 or 4 phormium leaves
 - Aspidistra leaves



Required for the session:

- A selection of different types of foliage including those with large, medium and small leaves of various colours and textures
- Green wire on a reel
- Stapler and staples
- Pins - dressmakers or with decorative heads

"Outside the Box" July 6th

- A bunch of supermarket or garden flowers but no more than 10 stems

Everything else will be provided and your imagination can run free as you create "outside the box"

"Manic Mechanics" February 3rd

- A low bowl/dish
- Metal pin holder (some will be available to borrow if you do not have one)
- Oasis Fix
- 3 large leaves eg ivy/fatsia/bergenia
- 2/3 twigs for height
- 3 to 5 single stem flowers eg spring flowers/iris/germini/chrysanthemums

AND

- A tall clear or opaque vase
- Pliable chicken wire eg 2.5 cm gauge or slightly larger
- Wire cutters and gloves
- 5 to 7 large leaves, plus 3 to 5 stems of taller foliage and 5 to 7 stems of filler foliage
- Your choice of spring flowers eg tulips, narcissi

"Let's Capture Spring" March 2nd

EITHER

- A round container about 7" to 8" diameter and height eg plant pot holder
- 1 block green foam
- 2 different bunches of spring flowers with long stems eg tulips, freesias (if bringing daffodils please bring a tall, thin drinking glass)
- Mixture of large and medium leaves plus filler foliage to cover foam
- 8 to 10 pliable willow or cornus or pussy willow stems about 26" long
- 10 midelino sticks (optional)
- Small number of wires or coloured wire on a reel

OR

- A low bowl
- Pin holder or foam to fit bowl (plus pot tape to secure)
- 3 large leaves and 4 medium leaves
- 7 stems of willow or cornus or pussy willow
- A bunch of tulips or flowers of your choice

"Taking the rough with the smooth" April 6th

To help you decide what to bring imagine that you are

Either: walking across the moors

Or: walking along a beach

- A shallow low-sided container eg seed tray/large pot plant drip tray
- Half block green foam (un-soaked)
- Knife
- 5 stems of flower eg bold such as germini or multi headed with small flowers
- Selection of different types of foliage with medium and small sized leaves
- Small amounts of different, interesting materials eg moss, lichen, bark, seed heads, fruits, cones, twigs, driftwood, pebbles, stones, shells, fabric, sisal, paper, bearing in mind the size of your container.
- Wires or mossing pins for fixing items into the design
